



**URGENT: UPDATED RECALL NOTICE**  
**PreveNile® West Nile Vaccine**

May 17, 2010

Dear Doctor:

On April 28, 2010, Intervet Inc notified you that we are conducting a voluntary recall of **all serials and all dose presentations of PreveNile® West Nile Vaccine**.

This recall is being conducted because Intervet has identified an increased incidence of adverse events related to currently marketed serials. Reported Adverse Events include acute anaphylaxis, systemic-type reactions, such as colic or respiratory distress and death following vaccination, alone and in combination with other products.

We have notified the United States Department of Agriculture, Center for Veterinary Biologics, of this recall action.

In our letter, we provided you with a list of serials for the product. To avoid any confusion, we are sending you this letter to reinforce what was stated in the previous letter -- that the recall includes **ALL SERIALS of PreveNile and ALL DOSE PRESENTATIONS**.

The numbers listed in the April 28<sup>th</sup> letter are the 'control' numbers which appear on the outside of the box in which the two vials (diluent and vaccine) are included. The control numbers are printed on the box because it is considered by the authorities as the 'final package' and are used to identify products. Each vial inside the box has its own 'serial' number and these were not listed on the letter.

Once again, **ALL SERIALS of PreveNile and ALL DOSE PRESENTATIONS** are being recalled at this time.

Please check your inventory immediately to identify whether or not you have any PreveNile vaccine. If you have any PreveNile product, please contact your distributor representative to arrange the return and credit for any returned product.

Intervet, as a responsible manufacturer of quality veterinary products, is committed to supplying you with quality products and sincerely regrets any inconvenience that this recall may cause.
