



Research Study



Some vaccines are recommended during pregnancy like the flu vaccine.

Whooping cough can be a serious illness for infants. When babies are 2 months old, they receive their first vaccine against whooping cough. Before this, the only possible protection may be from mom receiving the vaccine during pregnancy.

There is a research study at the IWK Health Centre to look at whether vaccinating pregnant women against whooping cough could provide protection to her unborn baby.
